Thank you for your interest in employment with the Floyd County Police Department.

We are **ALWAYS** taking applications from certified officers. Preference will be given to those applicants who are Georgia certified peace officers in good standing. We encourage you to accurately complete both applications and send them to Human Resources.

If you have not previously applied for a position with the Floyd County Police Department, we encourage you to view the application procedures. Complete both applications and return them:

Certified applicants should include a cover page which clearly indicates that you are a Georgia certified peace officer. Also include copies of your P.O.S.T. certification, training history, DD-214 (if applicable) and resume.

If you are a certified officer in Georgia, we encourage you to file your application as soon as possible due to the fact that when openings become available, we will fill the positions from the pool of applications from certified officers that are on file at the time the position becomes available.

Non-Certified?

For those who are interested in employment with the Floyd County Police Department but are not yet certified, we encourage you to continue your interest in law enforcement by furthering your education and independently attaining P.O.S.T. Certification. Opportunities for pre-service certification are available through Georgia Northwestern Technical College.

Students who are accepted will receive the mandated curriculum for P.O.S.T. certification and college credit. Information on this program is available by contacting James Pledger, at jpledger@gntc.edu.
