

Subject: Allotted Time to Acquire Alcohol License

As we briefly discussed at the January 19, 2016 ACC meeting, I am suggesting that we consider a Code Amendment which would affect the amount of time a liquor package, or any type of pouring establishment, has to acquire their license after ACC approval. Usually, the alcohol application comes on the front end of a project since the owner or operator wants to know they have been approved for alcohol before they fully commit. Currently, our Alcohol Code states that approvals for liquor package or any type of pouring license are valid for 90 days. At the end of that 90 days, the ACC may extend that period an additional 90 days. However, with some projects, such as the development and construction of new facilities, it takes more than 180 days to complete the development.

My suggestion is that City Code Section 3-177 be amended to allow the Alcohol Control Commission to approve an initial application for a period of 180 days. If the project is not complete, the applicant could petition the Alcohol Control Commission for more time. The ACC could evaluate these requests on a case-by-case basis. It seems that the ACC will be better served by having the ability to establish a timeframe as needed, rather than being handcuffed by a finite deadline in the City Code.

Assistant City Attorney Steven Mosley will have the actual Ordinance in hand for review at our February 15th ACC meeting.
