As you are aware, you have been instructed to appear at a License Hearing before the Alcohol Control Commission on March 21st. Please refer to my letter that was issued on February 18, 2016 regarding the reasons for this Hearing – consumption of alcohol after the allowed hours.


On March 5, 2016, Rome Police Officers visited El Patron due to a complaint of loud music. While at your establishment, the issue of loud music was discussed with Mr. Felix Guzman. There was also conversation between the Police Officers and Mr. Guzman regarding who was the manager at that time and alcohol consumption by Mr. Guzman.

As a result of this incident, the issues encountered by the Rome Police Department at El Patron on March 5th will be combined with the Hearing before the Alcohol Control Commission on March 21st.

This Hearing will take place at 5 p.m. on March 21, 2016 in the City Commission Chambers of City Hall, 601 Broad Street. At this Hearing, you will be expected to explain the circumstances regarding the March 5th incident. The Alcohol Control Commission could recommend that action be taken against the Alcohol or Entertainment License of El Patron. They could also recommend that El Patron be issued a monetary penalty. Any punitive action will have to be approved by the Rome City Commission. At the ACC Hearing, you may be represented by legal counsel (although it is not required), present witnesses, or question any City witness.

ON MARCH 5, 2016 (SATURDAY) AT APPROXIMATELY 1:30AM PFC HARRELL WAS DISPATCHED TO THE AREA OF HERITAGE WAY IN REFERENCE TO LOUD MUSIC IN THE AREA. THE COMPLAINANT ADVISED DISPATCH THEY COULD HEAR THE MUSIC FOR THE LAST TWO HOURS, BUT WANTED TO REMAIN ANONYMOUS. PFC HARRELL RESPONDED TO THE AREA AND WAS ABLE TO HEAR THE MUSIC. HE WAS ABLE TO DETERMINE THE MUSIC IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD WAS COMING FROM EL PATRON.

I RESPONDED TO EL PATRON WITH PFC HARRELL WHERE WE MADE CONTACT WITH DERRICK WILLIAMS WHO WAS WORKING SECURITY AND FELIX GUZMAN. WHEN THE DOOR OPENED TO THE CLUB A VERY STRONG ODOR OF MARIJUANA WAS COMING FROM INSIDE THE BUILDING AND THE MUSIC WAS VERY LOUD. VERBAL COMMANDS WERE GIVEN TO MR GUZMAN, WHO HAS BEEN THE ACTING MANAGER IN THE PAST, TO COME OUTSIDE AND TALK TO US. HE CONTINUED WALKING AWAY FROM ME. FINALLY AFTER BEING TOLD TO COME OUTSIDE WITH US AT LEAST 5 TIMES, HE DID. WHILE STANDING IN FRONT OF US WE NOTICED MR GUZMAN HAD THE ODOR OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ON HIS BREATH. WE TOLD MR GUZMAN THE REASON FOR THE CALL AND THAT HE WOULD BE GETTING A WARNING FOR IT SINCE THE COMPLAINANT WANTED TO REMAIN ANONYMOUS. WE THEN TOLD HIM AS ACTING MANAGER HE WAS NOT ALLOWED TO BE DRINKING ON THE PREMISES. HE THEN STATED HE WAS NOT THE MANAGER. I ASKED MR GUZMAN AT LEAST 10 TIMES WHO THE MANAGER WAS AND HE WOULD NOT GIVE US A NAME. I THEN ASKED TO SEE THE BUSINESS LICENSE AND IT SHOWED HIS BROTHER ON THE BUSINESS LICENSE. MR GUZMAN'S BROTHER WAS NOT ON THE SCENE. I ASKED MR WILLIAMS WHO WAS IN CHARGE AND WHO HIRED HIM TO WORK SECURITY THAT NIGHT AND HE INDICATED IT WAS MR GUZMAN. AFTER IT WAS DETERMINED THAT MR GUZMAN WAS THE MANAGER I CALLED LT KERCE AND CPT WILLINGHAM TO THE SCENE. THERE WAS SOME CONFUSION ABOUT THE CITY ORDINANCE AS TO WHETHER THE MANAGER WAS INCLUDED IN NOT BEING ALLOWED TO DRINK ON THE PREMISES. AFTER ADVISING MR GUZMAN HE WAS WOULD RECEIVE A WARNING FOR BOTH VIOLATIONS, WE LEFT THE SCENE. LATER WE DID CONFIRM THE CITY ORDINANCE 5-2 PROHIBITS ALL EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING THE MANAGER FROM DRINKING ON THE PREMISES.


Dear Mr. Guzman:

On February 14, 2016, the Rome Police Department issued a citation to Mr. Felix Guzman at El Patron, 1802 Redmond Circle. This citation was for allowing alcohol consumption after the allowed hours. The Rome Police Officer observed several persons consuming alcohol at El Patron after 2 a.m. on that date. Mr. Guzman will have to attend Municipal Court on his assigned court date to answer this charge.

As a result of this citation, you are hereby directed to appear at a License Hearing before the Rome Alcohol Control Commission. **This Hearing will take place at 5 p.m. on Monday, March 21, 2016 in the City Commission Chambers of City Hall, 601 Broad Street.** At this Hearing, you will be expected to explain the circumstances surrounding this alleged violation. The Alcohol Control Commission could recommend that action be taken against the Alcohol License at El Patron. They could also recommend that El Patron be issued a monetary penalty. Any punitive action will have to be approved by the City Commission. At the ACC Hearing, you may be represented by legal counsel (although it is not required), present witnesses, or question any City witness. You may recall that a Hearing was held at the November 16, 2015 Alcohol Control Commission due to your establishment allowing alcohol consumption after 2 a.m., and for furnishing alcohol to a person under 21. As a result of that Hearing, El Patron was issued a letter of warning.

ON FEBRUARY 14, 2016 (SUNDAY) AT 2:11AM I, PFC Z COLVIN, AND PFC RIDLING DID A WALK THROUGH AT EL PATRON LOCATED 1802 REDMOND CIR. I HAD BEEN SITTING IN THE PARKING LOT OF THE ROME FOOD MART NEXT DOOR SINCE ABOUT 1:30AM DOING PAPERWORK. I NOTICED THERE WERE STILL OVER 30 CARS IN THE PARKING LOT AFTER CLOSING TIME. I COULD STILL SEE A FLASHING LIGHT AND HEAR MUSIC COMING FROM INSIDE THE CLUB.

WHEN I WALKED IN I OBSERVED THERE TO BE AROUND 200 PEOPLE STILL INSIDE THE CLUB. THERE WERE AT LEAST 20 PEOPLE WITH DRINKS IN THEIR HANDS. I STOOD INSIDE FOR ABOUT 4 MINUTES BEFORE THE MANAGER, FELEX GUZMAN, TOLD THE BAND TO STOP PLAYING. I THEN GOT MR GUZMAN'S INFORMATION AND WENT OUT TO MY PATROL CAR WHERE I PRINTED OFF A CITATION FOR VIOLATING THEIR POURING LICENSE BY ALLOWING CUSTOMERS TO CONSUME ALCOHOL ON THE PREMISES AFTER 2:00AM. I WENT BACK INSIDE THE CLUB, ADVISED MR GUZMAN OF THE VIOLATION, ISSUED HIM THE CITATION, AND GAVE HIM HIS COPY AFTER HE SIGNED MY COPY.
