Floyd County is requesting quotes to remove and rebuild the existing Veterans Memorial to a new location. **This project is to be completed before 11 November 2016 “Veterans Day”**. The intent is to award this project immediately due to the time constraints involved.

All quotes will be submitted on the attached quote sheet. Additional information may be submitted with quote.

Quotes are due no later than **2pm 3 Oct 2016**. Quotes may be submitted by Email, Fax, US Mail or hand delivered to this office. Fax 706 290-6099 – Email: Graye@floydcountyga.org. Quotes are to remain valid for a period of 30 days from the date of quote. Awards may be for all or part of what is submitted.

A Mandatory Site Visit is scheduled for **3pm on 23 Sept 2016**. Contractors will meet at the steps in front of the Old Historic Courthouse located at 4 Government Plaza Rome Ga. 30161.

Submissions **must include** a completed E-Verify Form (Contract Affidavit and Agreement). This form is provided in this RFQ. Companies that do not provide this will not be considered.

Typically award notification will be by email. Tabulations will be posted to the Floyd County Website and the Georgia Procurement Registry in approximately 24hrs after the due date/time.

Payment Options, Invoicing, and Terms and Conditions

If payment is made by check, Floyd County will pay invoice(s) within 30 days of receipt of a valid invoice. Supplier may be required to send a current W-9 prior to have a Purchase Order issued. The Issued Purchase Order will serve to initiate the order when payment is going to be made by check. If payment is made by credit card this information will be provided at the time of order, however, the successful suppliers must agree that no charge will be run until such time as the products have shipped or the service has been provided. Scope of Work: Floyd County is requesting services to move our eternal flame pedestal. Work will include demo existing marble pedestal and reconstruct in nearby location. New location will need to have power and gas connections. Contractor will responsible for protecting all existing structures and utilities. Ryan Davis Facilities Manager will be the contractors contact for this project.

Contractor will

- Attend the Mandatory Site Visit
- Provide all labor, equipment and materials
- Submit a completed Contract affidavit (E-Verify)
- Provide a completion date prior 11 November 2016
- Use existing Marble Facing from the current pedestal, Measurements are the Contractors responsibility
- Tie in Gas and Electrical at the new location
- Mount a bronze plaque to the marble facing. Plaque will be provided by Floyd County
- Contractor is invited to attend the Flame of Freedom lighting ceremony on Veterans Day 2016

EXECUTION

Remove existing pedestal: Every effort must be taken to reuse existing marble. Marble slabs should be removed and stored for use on new pedestal. Once marble is removed contractor will be responsible for demo and removal of concrete base inside pedestal. Concrete is assumed to be roughly the size of pedestal and reinforced with rebar. All material must be demolished to 8" below level of surrounding concrete. All demo material will be removed by contractor.

New Concrete Pad: New concrete pad will be 4'X4'X12" 3000psi concrete with rebar matting New pad will be centered between existing fence and inside edge of brick. Exact pad placement must be approved by county prior to installation. Pad will have stub ups for electrical and natural gas. Size of stub up will be as needed for proper utility delivery.

New Pedestal: New pedestal will be made of concrete 48" High by 24" wide and deep. This pedestal will have rebar reinforcement as necessary to provide adequate support and strength to structure. Saved marble will be attached to pedestal. Concrete for pedestal will have rough in for plumbing and electrical. This will terminate at the marble top of the pedestal.

Access Panel: One side of the new pedestal will have the marble cut at roughly the midway point. This will allow access to the flame controls. This removable piece of marble will be attached to the pedestal using stainless steel screws. Exact size of panel and location of screws will be determined in the field.

Existing concrete: Existing concrete with star pattern will be repaired to create a solid star. All other concrete will be finished to new condition.

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General Instructions

Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code unless otherwise noted.

Purpose of Form

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN to the person requesting it (the requester) and, when applicable, to:

1. Certify that the TIN you are giving is correct (or you are waiting for a number to be issued).
2. Certify that you are not subject to backup withholding, or
3. Claim exemption from backup withholding if you are a U.S. exempt payee. If applicable, you are also certifying that as a U.S. person, your allocable share of any partnership income from a U.S. trade or business is not subject to the withholding tax on foreign partners' share of effectively connected income.

Note. If a requester gives you a form other than Form W-9 to request your TIN, you must use the requester's form if it is substantially similar to this Form W-9.

Definition of a U.S. person. For federal tax purposes, you are considered a U.S. person if you are:

- An individual who is a U.S. citizen or U.S. resident alien,
- A partnership, corporation, company, or association created or organized in the United States or under the laws of the United States,
- An estate (other than a foreign estate), or
- A domestic trust (as defined in Regulations section 301.7701-7).

Special rules for partnerships. Partnerships that conduct a trade or business in the United States are generally required to pay a withholding tax on any foreign partners' share of income from such business. Further, in certain cases where a Form W-9 has not been received, a partnership is required to presume that a partner is a foreign person, and pay the withholding tax. Therefore, if you are a U.S. person that is a partner in a partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States, provide Form W-9 to the partnership to establish your U.S. status and avoid withholding on your share of partnership income.
