Notice of Request for Bid #039-15
Stage Upgrade and Renovation of Rome City Auditorium

The City of Rome, Georgia is seeking sealed bids for stage upgrades and renovations to the City Auditorium as described in the specifications of Bid # 039-15. The bids will be received in the Purchasing Department of City Hall, 601 Broad Street 30161 until July 16, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. At that time and place the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids should be clearly marked on the exterior of the envelope "Bid #039-15, City Auditorium Renovations". No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for receipt of proposal for a period of 60 days.

Work to be done:

The work to be done consists of furnishing all equipment, products and performing all labor necessary to renovate and upgrade the stage area, demolish existing structure and build a new structure according to the drawings provided.

Requirements and Documents:

Specifications, drawings and Bid documents may be obtained at the City of Rome Georgia website. www.romefloyd.com where one may print the documents. Drawings are in a 24" x 36" format. All addenda will be posted on the website and it is the responsibility of interested parties to periodically check the website for any new information that may be posted. Plans and specifications may be reviewed at the City of Rome Purchasing Department conference room.

Bonds:

Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the base bid. A Georgia Resident Agent must countersign all bid bonds.

A faithful Performance Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the Bid, and a Labor & Materials Payment Bond in the amount of not less than the amount of said Bid, one hundred percent (100%), as provided by Georgia Code Section 23-1704 and 23-1705 shall be furnished by the successful bidders.

The City of Rome reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive informalities and to resolicit if deemed necessary.
