I also attest that while such animals are in possession of the authorized person that they will comply with all provisions of the Georgia Animal Protection Act as outlined in §O.C.G.A. 4-11-1 and the Georgia Animal Protection Act rules Chapter 40-13-13. This agreement may be terminated at any time for any reason by either party. In order for the Licensed Rescue organization to terminate this authorization the Animal Shelter Manager must be provided written notification by the licensed rescue that this agreement has been terminated within 7 days from the date that the authorized person's privileges have been revoked. In order for the licensed Animal Shelter to terminate this agreement they must notify the licensed rescue organization, in writing, within 7 days that authorization to obtain animals has been revoked. Correspondence may be by email, however, it must be signed and printed by the authorized sender. This agreement/authorization must be kept on file at the licensed animal shelter and must be made readily available for inspection by GDA during normal business hours.
