Sealed bids will be received until **2:00PM** (local time), on **May 10, 2018** at the office of the Floyd County Purchasing Director, located in the Floyd County Administration Building, 12 East Fourth Avenue, Suite 106, Rome, Georgia. Sealed bids will then and there be publicly opened and read aloud in the office of the Purchasing Director. Late bids will not be accepted.

**This project consists of performing rehabilitation measures on the Airport's Crosswind Runway. The existing asphalt wearing surface is cracked, aged, and is creating FOD issues. General work items include sealing existing cracks, application of a single surface treatment, bituminous pavement milling, an asphalt overlay, and pavement marking.**
