PREA Informational Bulletin

Floyd County Corrections has a ZERO TOLERANCE policy for sexual assault, sexual abuse, or sexual harassment of offenders in custody. Offenders and staff have a right to be free from retaliation when reporting allegations of sexual assault, sexual abuse, and sexual harassment.

REPORTING

Any information regarding sexual abuse or sexual harassment of an offender/resident can be reported via the sources below:

CONFIDENTIAL SUPPORT SERVICES
