**ADDENDUM I**  
**QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

1. Will you allow a separate flooring and painting bid, while other contractors handle the other trades? **We prefer dealing with one general contractor.**
2. What quality and size of tile and cove do you require? Example: 12” x 12” tile with 6” cove x 3/16” grout line. **This would be acceptable.**
3. If 6” tile cove base is used in the restrooms, do you want the 6” wood cove removed? **Yes**
4. That grout type i.e. sanded not epoxy? **Yes**
5. What transitions do you require between the tile and the laminate? **Adequate transition, whatever is standard/basic.**
6. Do you require a special joint treatment at tile to shower apron? **No**
7. Will the City be responsible for trimming the bottoms of doors to accommodate flooring? **No**
8. Will the bunk room lockers remain in place and therefore, we will “cut-around” each? **No**
9. Will the City be responsible for removing/replacing 1” shoe molding to accommodate flooring? **No**
10. The window, walk-through door and bay door casings appear to be wood, therefore, they too would get painted correct? **Yes**
11. The vent boxes at gables, cupola, window shutters appear to be wood, if so, they too get painted? **Yes**
