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Addendum I **Questions and Answers for SCADA Systems Radio Communication System:** **Bid #20-0213**

The following is responses to questions to clarify the information regarding the SCADA RFP.

TANKS

Question: There are thirteen (13) tank sites listed in the RFP No. 20-0213 GPS specifications. These sites coincide with the operating system as DFA knows it. However, DFA has one additional tank called Crystal Springs Tank that is not listed in the GPS specifications. Tank's Latitude 34.406085, Longitude -85.214553. Will this tank also be included in this project for a total of fourteen (14) tank sites?

Answer: The Crystal Springs tank is not to be included, this tank is out of service.

RADIO REPEATER

Question: There is one (1) repeater site within this radio network called Old Mill Springs Repeater whose location does not coincide with the Repeater site listed in the RFP No. 20-0213 GPS specifications. The RFP indicates one (1) Repeater located at 7587 Cave Spring Rd SW, 30124 which is roughly the intersection of Cave Springs Road and Mason Circle. The Repeater location that DFA knows is just north of the intersection of Cave Springs Road SW and Cemetery Drive on the side of Cave Springs Road (Hwy 411/Hwy 53). This Old Mill Springs Repeater location is Latitude 34.119413, Longitude -85.327467. See Google pic attached. Please clarify as to the radio repeater location within this RFP.

Answer: The repeater is close to the intersection of Cave Springs Road and Cemetery Drive.

PUMP STATIONS

Question: There are twenty-two (22) pump station sites listed in the RFP No 20-0213 GPS specifications. There appears there are seventeen (17) pump stations/wells in the operating radio network and these sites coincide with the RFP specifications except for a site named Hwy 156 Pump Station. The Hwy 156 site coincides with Everett Springs Pump Station and is included in the seventeen (17) pump stations.

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The following five (5) pump stations sites included in the RFP are unknown and not part of the current operating radio network for the SCADA System. Will these five (5) sites be included in the RFP No. 20-0213 project and be integrated into the SCADA System as part of this RFP project?

For the five (5) sites listed below, the GPS coordinates included in the RFP do not seem correct. If included in this project, please re-verify the GPS coordinates and make the corrected coordinates available.

1. Rockdale Booster
2. Armuchee Trail Pump Station
3. Wildwood Pump Station
4. Moran Lake Pump Station
5. Ramblewood Pump Station
