Notice is hereby given that Floyd County, Georgia proposes to let a Contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, upon sealed bids, for the furnishing of all labor, material, equipment and other things necessary for the construction of the:

Sealed bids will be received until 2:00 PM (local time), on Thursday, June 11th, 2020 at the office of the Floyd County Purchasing Director, located in the Floyd County Administration Building, 12 East Fourth Avenue, Suite 106, Rome, Georgia 30162. Sealed bids will then and there be publicly opened and read aloud in the office of the Purchasing Director. Late bids will not be accepted.

The purpose of this project is to construct grading and drainage improvements for the proposed extension of Runway 1/19 covering approximately a 40-acre site. The overall scope of work consists primarily of the performance of clearing & grubbing (approx. 3 acres), excavation and embankment formation (approx. 150,000 cubic yards), installation of drainage improvements (approx. 2,900 linear feet), installation of chain-link perimeter fencing (approx. 3,000 linear feet), as well as installation and maintenance of various erosion control measures.

Pre-Bid Conference and Site Visit will be held at 10:00 AM (local time) on Thursday, May 28th, 2020 at the Airport Terminal conference room, 304 Russell Field Road, Rome, GA 30165. Site visit will follow.

Floyd County encourages these firms to compete and encourages non-minority firms to provide for the participation of MBE firms through partnerships, joint ventures, subcontracts, and other contractual opportunities.

Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the base bid. All bonds must be signed or countersigned by a Georgia Resident Agent.

A Performance Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the bid, and a Labor Materials Payment Bond in the amount of not less than the amount of said Bid, one hundred percent (100%), shall be furnished by the successful bidders.

The right is also reserved to the Board of Commissioners of Floyd County, Georgia to reject any and all bids and to waive any and all technicalities or informalities. Any contract executed pursuant to this notice shall be binding upon the Board of Commissioners of Floyd County, Georgia, as such, but will not create a liability expressed or implied, against any members of the Board of Commissioners of Floyd County, the Chairman of the Board, or employee of said County, in his or her individual capacity.
