In accordance with the THIRD ORDER EXTENDING DECLARATION OF STATEWIDE JUDICIAL EMERGENCY entered by the Honorable Harold D. Melton, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Georgia, on June 12, 2020, the Judges of the Superior Court of Floyd County have developed Operating Guidelines to address how expanded in-court proceedings will be conducted to protect the health of litigants, lawyers, court personnel, judges and the public. These guidelines have been submitted to the Administrative Office of the Courts and they will be posted at <https://georgiacourts.gov/covid-19-operating-guidelines/>. The public is advised to pay particular attention to the following excerpt from the guidelines relating to entry into the Floyd County Courthouse:

FACE MASKS REQUIRED

All persons entering the Courthouse or Courthouse Annex will be required to wear a face mask. Floyd County Government may supply face masks to some individuals to meet the requirements, but it is anticipated that there will be insufficient face masks available to supply all persons who appear at the Courthouse without their own face masks. Entrance to the Courthouse and Annex may be denied to any individual without a face mask if there is no mask available to be supplied by the County.
