



Notice of Property Tax Increase

The Rome City Commission announces its intention to hold a Public Hearing at the City Commission meeting on Monday, July 13th, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall, 601 Broad Street concerning the proposed 2020 millage tax rate. The proposed combined rates for the City Government and City Schools of 27.536 will result in no increase of millage rate from the prior year but will be an increase of 2.7% (.732 mils) over the calculated rollback rate of 26.804. For a non-homestead property the estimated City and City School tax for a current \$125,000 market valued home would have been \$1,377 in 2019. At the proposed rate for 2020, the estimated tax will be \$1,377 and at the 2020 roll back rate, the estimated tax would be \$1,340. For non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$100,000 the proposed 2020 rate of 27.536 would be \$1,101 compared to the rollback rate of 26.804 and \$1,072, a 2.7% increase. All concerned citizens are invited to this public hearing. Additional Public Hearings will be held on Thursday, July 23rd at 10 a.m. and Monday July 27th at 6:30 p.m.
