Questions and Answers I

WEAPONS SALE - FCPD Bid #20-1022

Q: We are a FFL and have a variance to receive firearms that are not legal to sell, such as defaced, illegally modified, sawed off, full-auto or destructive devices (launchers, suppressors, etc.) Do you have a quantity of these recovered firearms or devices that are not legal or are otherwise not saleable?

A: The answer to the question is Yes we do have these type firearms at times but not a significant quantity. However, under no circumstance have we ever transferred these defaced, modified or otherwise illegal firearms to the public. We destroy these type firearms by industrial process after a petition has been presented to the court and the same authorized by a Superior Court Judge. With some firearms (firearms that are of the same make and model as those within department inventory) we do typically ask the court for a clause in the petition to remove parts and to repurpose the parts for repairs made to firearms within the police department's inventory by qualified departmental armorers. Hope this helps.
